

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AUC14 AND ABO25
(UCKINGTON AND BODDINGTON PARISHES) TEWKESBURY BOROUGH ORDER 2021

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of Public Bridleway AUC 14 in the Parish of Uckington from its junction with Moat Lane extending in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 310 metres and then carrying on along ABO 25 in the parish of Boddington for approximately a further 380 metres in a south easterly direction to its junction with the Old Gloucester Road ("the Footpath") is satisfied that use of the Footpaths should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near them.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 23rd day of December 2021 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months from the date when the Footpath was closed initially by Emergency Notice being the 2nd December 2021.
2. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Public Footpaths AUC14 and ABO25 (Uckington and Boddington Parishes) Tewkesbury Borough Order 2021".

GENERAL

3. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed on foot along the Footpaths;
4. The Footpaths fall in Uckington and Boddington Parishes in the Tewkesbury District in the County of Gloucestershire;
